Scripture

Primary Verses: Hebrews 10:19-26

Have everyone read the verses out loud. It's best not to comment during the reading.

Observations

Hebrews 10:19-22 – Imagine yourself entering into God's presence...

- What do you think that experience would be like?
- How did Jesus make this possible?
- How would you feel emotionally as you enter into His presence? What tension would you feel?

Hebrews 10:23-26 – The writer of Hebrews is encouraging us to be participants in our faith.

- How do you fit into the story of involvement?
- What parts of the story are you weak in?
- How can you do what the writer is encouraging us to do?

Hebrews 10:25 – The writer of Hebrews tells us to not give up meeting together.

- Why is meeting together have such high value?
- How does meeting together with other believers grow us in Christ?

Application:

Pastor Troy mentioned that "Who you do life with determines how you will do life." How are you doing?

How has sharing life together benefited you?

How do the following five practices grow you and the church?

Praying together, Studying together, Serving together, Having fun together, Sharing life together.

Describe the value groups has brought to your life?
