

I believe Christmas is a season of hope! I have great hope that the Lord will continue to bless us! We have many new opportunities to share the Good News this December. You can invite your friends and neighbors to Christmas events that will not only bring them joy but also the hope of salvation. The December 3 "Hanging of the Greens" service is a service of carols and readings when we decorate the church for Christmas. You bring hope to those who have given up on hope and you bring light to those who have seen only darkness.

This is the season of great hope and joy. I pray that you will share the story of Jesus with your friends and family this Christmas season.
