





The Pastor's Letter



New Beginnings

March is preparation time. We have entered into the season of Lent on the church calendar. It is a time of reflection, confession and new beginnings. We are looking ahead to Easter when Jesus rose from the grave. His resurrection was not only a new beginning for him but also for those of us who follow him. His resurrection promises that we too will one day rise in Christ to eternal life with a new body and a new existence. Easter can be a time of new beginnings for your family, friends, neighbors and coworkers who have not yet experienced the joy of resurrection life in Christ.

In the last few weeks we have had major tragedies and the passing of a spiritual giant. The shootings at Parkland High School and the death of 17 innocent people has rocked the nation. There are demands for gun control, school safety, and an increased police presence on school grounds, mental health awareness, and numerous other suggestions to make sure a tragedy like this does not happen again. People wonder how this could happen. They come face to face with death and evil. They look for answers. They face their own mortality and the fragility of life. We mourn the passing of Billy Graham. His life and legacy have impacted millions of people around the world. He was a man of integrity. Everyone wants love in their lives and Jesus is the true source of love that continues into eternity.

I believe you can agree with me that we have a Holy Week filled with interesting and appealing events. You can confidently invite your friends to attend. Pray hard for their salvation and urge them to attend these events with you. They just may experience a new beginning that will last into eternity!
