Title: Staying on the Beaten Path Text: Psalm 103:7, Jeremiah 6:16

Questions to Consider:

- He made known his ways (well-worn path) to Moses, his deeds to the people of Israel
 - How did God make his ways known to Moses? (See Exodus 33:11, 13 and Deuteronomy 34:10)
 - How did this impact Moses' relationship with God?
 - Compare Exodus 33:11 and John 15:15, how do they relate to one another?
 - o What deeds did the people of Israel see God do?
 - How did that impact their relationship with God?
 - Read Exodus 17:7 and Numbers 14:1-4. What does this show about how God's deeds impacted the people?
- He told his plans to Moses, let his people see his mighty acts
 - What is the difference between Moses being told face to face and the people seeing?
 - Compare this with Jesus' interaction with the crowds that followed him (See John 6:41-44).
 - Why were the crowds following Jesus?
 - What did they want from him?
 - What did they NOT want from him?
 - Why is it critical to know God's way and not just see his deeds?
 - What is the lesson of the warning about the wheat and chaff in Matthew 3:12?

How does that apply to us (the church) today? To you personally?
