# Title: Identity Determines Destiny Text: Exodus 1

#### **Questions to Consider:**

- Read Exodus 1:1-11.
  - O Why did the Israelites go from freedom to slavery?
    - Was it their fault? Why or why not?
    - Was it God's fault? Why or why not?
  - "God is proactive rather than reactive."
    - Define what that means.
    - Why is this important to realize and remember?
      - Have you gone through tough times where it felt like you were being beaten down, crushed, and worn out? Perhaps even now?
      - Why did God allow the Egyptians to enslave the Israelites?
        - Was God unconcerned with the brutality of their slavery?
        - o Had he forgotten about them?
  - How does the Israelites' enslavement to the Egyptians parallel humankind's enslavement to sin?
- Read Exodus 1:12-14.
  - O How does God "turn up the heat?" Why?
    - Has God ever "turned up the heat" on you? How? Why?
    - Despite being slaves, how had the Israelites become accustomed to their plight?
      - Did they want to be delivered from their slavery?
      - Why or why not?
  - "Our identity determines our destiny."
    - What was the Israelites identity? How had they lost it?
    - What was the Israelites destiny? How had they lost it?
      - How does this parallel many Christians' lives today?
      - Read Galatians 5:1 and John 10:10
        - Why did Christ set us free from slavery to sin?
        - O What is His purpose for us?

#### • Read Exodus 1:15-17, 22

- O How do things go from bad to worse for the Israelites?
  - Once again, why would God allow this?
  - If God wasn't punishing them, what was He doing?
- If God's purpose toward us is ALWAYS to bless us (see Jeremiah 29:11), then why does He allow such awful things to happen to them? To us?
  - What was God preparing them for?
  - What is God preparing us for?
