

Questions to consider:

- 2. What might Jesus have stooped down and written in the dust (see 8:6)?
 - a. Compare Exodus 31:18 and John 8:6 see any connections? What are they?
 - b. How would you react/respond if you:
 - i. Were the woman? In the crowd?
 - ii. How did Jesus respond? Why did He respond this way?
 - c. How did Jesus as "the Light of the world" change this woman's life?

- 3. What usually happens when people's sins and failures are dragged out into the open and exposed?
 - a. Why are people so willing to judge and condemn others despite their own weaknesses?
 - b. Why is Jesus so UNWILLING to judge and condemn others despite his right to do so?
 - c. Who do you need to forgive and "drop the rock?"


