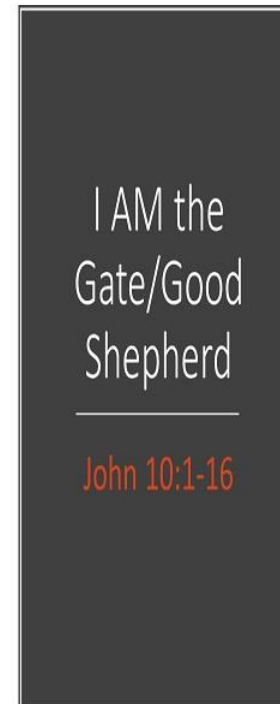

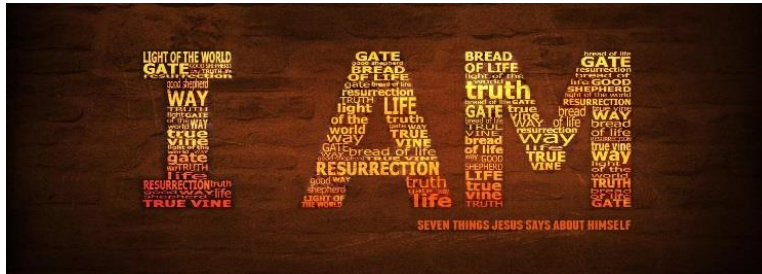

**Questions to consider:**

***“I AM THE GATE” – JOHN 10:1-10***



What is the purpose of a wall or gate?

*Why did Jesus use this analogy to describe himself?*

*What are the characteristics of sheep? How does this apply to us? (See Isaiah 53:6)*

Why does Jesus describe the enemy as a thief and robber?

*What’s the difference between a thief and a robber?*

*What point is he trying to make? (See 10:1-5)*

*When are the sheep safe? When are they in danger?*

*What is the thief’s agenda for the sheep versus Jesus’?*



How do you recognize the voice of the true shepherd?

*Why is it difficult to recognize his voice among all the others?*

*How can you train yourself to hear his voice above all the others?*

*What is the difference between the true shepherd and the hired hand?*

What does Jesus mean when he says, “I have other sheep. I must bring them also.”?

*Who are these other sheep?*

*What role do we play in bringing them to Jesus?*
