Title: Wisdom and Folly

Text: Proverbs 8 and 9



King Solomon *was* considered one of the wisest people that's ever lived (see 1 Kings 4:29-34)

From where did Solomon get his wisdom?

Despite Solomon's wisdom, what mistakes did he make?

(see 1 Kings 11)

What can we learn from Solomon's example? (See Ecclesiastes 12:13-14)

Read Psalm 119:99-101 – how can we apply these verses?

What does the Bible mean when it says “fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom?” – Proverbs 9:10

What does “fear of the Lord” look like? How does it lead to wisdom?

What does God's definition of wisdom look like? – see James 3:17

How can we grow in God's wisdom? – see Proverbs 8:32-36

Questions to consider:

What is the difference between wisdom and folly?

Give some examples:

From the Bible

From your own experience

Who does the Bible define as a fool and why?
