God's Kingdom Building: Family Promise

Update from Tyler Shade, Executive Director Unfortunately, the cost of housing continues to rise, and safe and affordable housing remains scarce. Family Promise now spends more funds per family to assist them in securing and remaining in housing than ever before.

Families now remain in our programs for much longer periods of time, as it takes our team and families significantly longer to identify units that are safe and affordable for the families we're serving. While Family Promise spends more per family each year, we're proud that according to our most recent audit, 85 cents of every dollar donated to Family Promise is spent directly on our programming and benefits for families.

One of the ways that Family Promise continues to be able to provide safe housing is through their local volunteer network (that's us!)

Four weeks each year, Heritage provides evening meals & general grocery supplies to the families staying at Family Promise's Hospitality Center (2501 Milltown Rd). Our next hosting week begins next Sunday, April 7 and runs through Saturday, April 13.

Please use our SignUp Genius link to let us know which night you are able to help with. You may choose to provide the entire meal (for 4 families) or find some friends to divide & conquer with. We ask that you have dinner ready to serve by 6:00 pm, eat with the families, and then clean up. (Usually takes no more than 2 hours)
