God': Kingdom Building:

Gary & Phyllis Waldecker, serving with Third Millennium Ministries

Third Millennium Ministries has an accredited online seminary that offers two degrees, one of which is a Masters of Arts in Christian Studies. The program is currently offered in English and in Spanish. The seminary recently asked me to teach a class in Spanish. I'm teaching the Thirdmill course called "New Testament Kingdom and Covenant." I have students from Colombia, Argentina, Chile and Florida. Since I have a doctorate in education, they also asked me to create and teach the course that helps the students write their masters thesis. I'm glad to be doing this since it fits my gifts, makes use of my Spanish and enables me to invest in future leaders of the Hispanic church.

Thirdmill has recently decided to have all staff members study the Thirdmill courses. The staff--about 60 people from all over the world--meets for this purpose in small groups every other week for an hour. **Thirdmill has asked me to write the study/application guides for that program.** We are currently studying the course "Building Your Theology."

For most of March, Third Millennium Ministries has been in the process of switching its accounting software. As a result, I have not been able to find out how much support has come in for my ministry since March 4. But based on what has come in since January 1, **it looks like I'll be taking a cut in pay beginning this month**. Although we have gained new support, we have also lost some, and this is the result.
