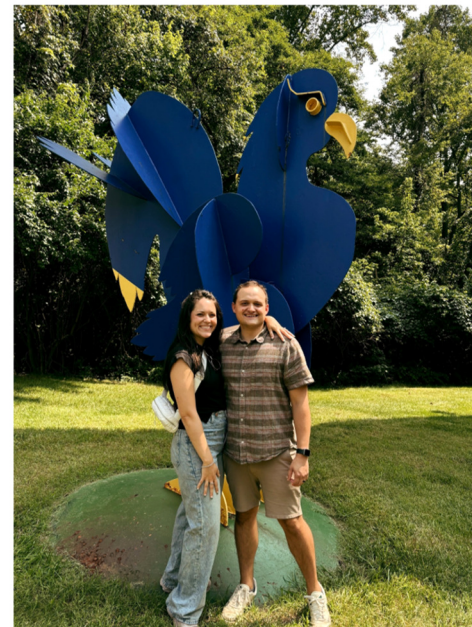
Bring on the students!

MNA (Mission to North America) Disaster Response

This week, MNA Disaster Response has already:

- Delivered a load of chainsaws & a skid steer loader, and had a chainsaw team begin removing fallen trees at Antioch, PCA
- Transported a load of flood mitigation supplies to St Petersburg to support members gutting & mucking St Petersburg PCA which was hit by a tidal surge and flooded deeply.
- Serviced & transported a large mobile generator to First PCA Augusta, SC to repower a church building repurposed to house traveling chainsaw teams. Volunteers arrived Tuesday to begin work.
- Transported a mobile shower to Redeemer PCA, Valdosta, GA to support chainsaw teams there.
- Sent a specialist to First Presbyterian Augusta, GA to field train first responders in skid steer operation to support the chainsaw/ debris clean up teams.

Pray for endurance for your MNA Disaster Response. This is a marathon, not a sprint. We are watching God work in these disaster-affected communities. The hands-on compassion of Christ is being displayed to a watching & curious world.
