After 8+ months on campus, Reformed University Fellowship has been "re-recognized" as an official **Registered Student Organization** at the University of Delaware. This process was initiated and carried forward by the work of students who believe in the ministry of RUF and want it to flourish again at UD. The immediate result of this is public recognition by the Office of Student Involvement, which means:

- Our organization can book rooms and host events on campus, set up presentation or activity tables in the student centers, and participate in activity fairs.
- Pace will be an official "religious advisor" and active member of the University Religious Leader's Organization (URLO).
- Students are able to locate and join our group through the student activity portal.
