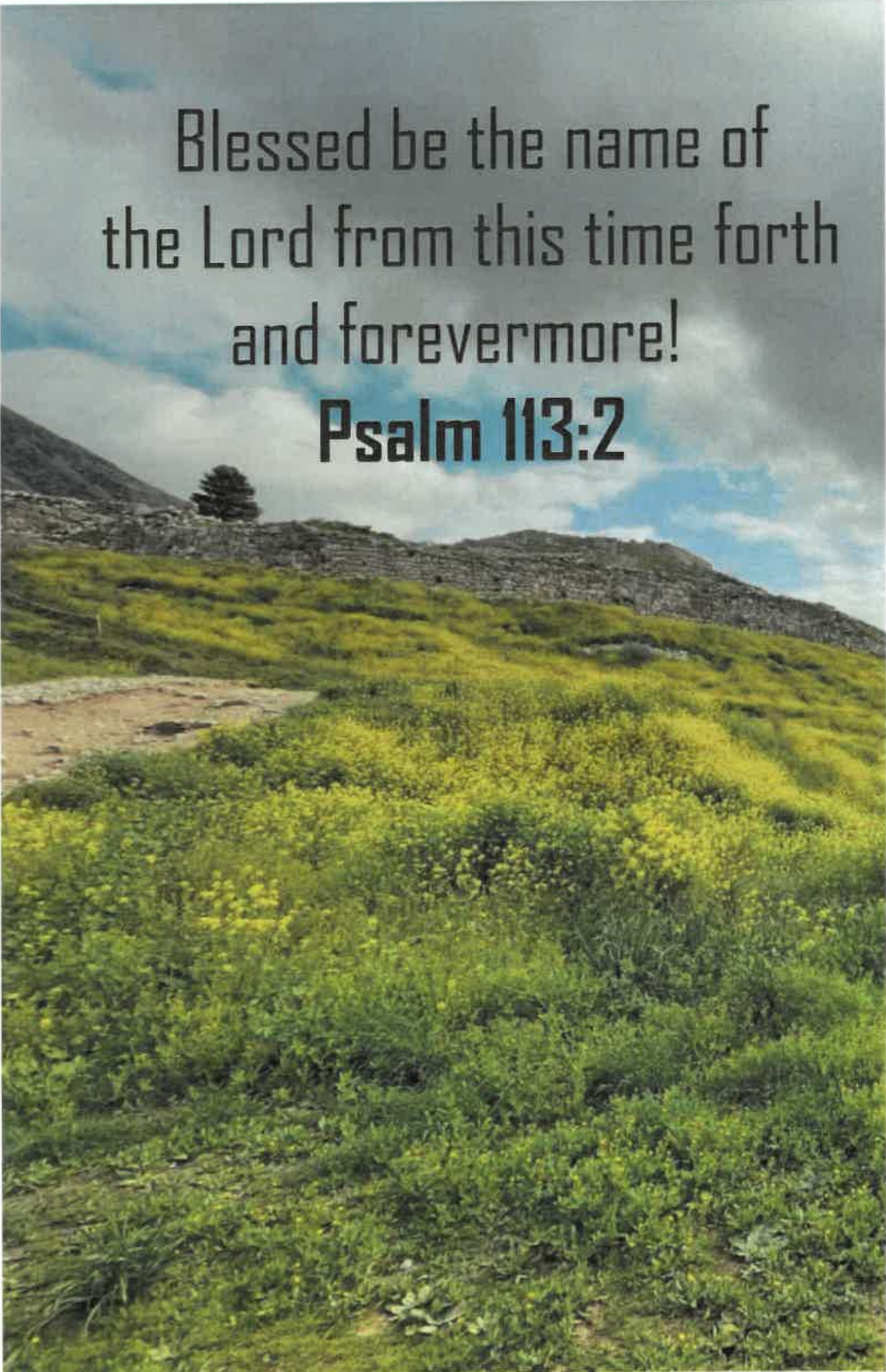

Confessing our Need of God's Sustaining Grace:

Heavenly Father, we confess that we boast about our own righteousness before You. We try to perform to impress You and those around us. We are motivated by spiritual pride. Dear Father, forgive us when we love ourselves rather than love You and our neighbors. Lord Jesus, You loved and cared for people in their suffering, even when they invaded Your privacy and disrupted Your plans. Dear Jesus, forgive us for loving ourselves and being calloused about the suffering of others. We have no righteousness of our own. Our only hope is that Christ is our righteousness. By faith, Christ's righteousness is credited to our spiritual account. Holy Spirit, keep us mindful of our sins and trespasses so that we will come to love the righteousness of Jesus. Melt our stony hearts with gratitude for the mercy that we have received until compassion and love flow out of us like a river. In Christ's name, Amen.

Assurance of God's Sustaining Grace: Philippians 3:3-9(ESV)

For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh—though I myself have reason for confidence in the flesh also. If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless. But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For His sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may

gain Christ and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith —
