## God's Kingdom Building: Geneva Look/After Relief Fund

In 1973, the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in America formed a committee to care not only for our ministry workers now but for the future widows of pastors. Today, the Relief Fund provides financial assistance and support to PCA pastors, widows, and ministry workers in need.

### Who is Ministerial Relief For?

The Relief Fund serves PCA pastors (Teaching Elders) and their wives, PCA missionaries, and PCA ministry staff during every season of ministry.

- Help with monthly assistance for retired or disabled pastors & widows
- Reimbursement for up to 6 months of health insurance premiums for pastors & their families when they're between calls
- General assistance for one-time or short-term emergencies
- One-time payment to the surviving spouse and in-home dependents on the death of a PCA pastor or spouse
- Grants for PCA pastor's wives to access affordable & confidential Christian counseling.

**Each year our Christmas Eve offering goes entirely to the Geneva Look/After Relief Fund.**
