Update from John Freeman, Director

"...not long ago a guy called our office for help with his porn struggles who had found one of our ministry magazines in the seat pocket in front of him on a plane flight from Denver to Philadelphia...that's just like God to have had someone else on the plane who read our magazine . . . and then leave it in the seat pocket, **not knowing that the very next person to sit there would need to know about the ministry!**

Another encouraging thing happened this week here. I had lunch with a former Harvest USA group ministry participant from back 30 + years ago. "Tina" had first come to our ministry, in the late '80's, as a very gender-confused young woman and involved in a committed same-sex relationship. But, somehow in ways only He can do it, the Lord slowly drew her heart to himself in one of our Women's Discipleship Support Groups, back then. **Her radical encounter with Jesus led her to a journey of walking in faith and obedience.** Her healing in Christ was also facilitated by being involved in a local church we guided her to, where some of the people there knew her story and also walked with her.

As she shared over lunch, **I marveled again at God's grace and saving, keeping hand.** Tina related to me how God was still working in her life and how he was now using her in the lives of others. Still an active member of her local PCA church, she now is leading two women's Bible studies there. What a sweet-kiss from Jesus all this was to me. To know that there are people out-there who've been involved here, getting ministry three or four decades ago, who are still walking with Jesus as 'new creatures' is Christ is both humbling and thrilling!
