God's Kingdom Building:

Scott & Meghan Dillon, serving with MTW (Mission To the World) and headed to Bogota, Columbia



The Dillons have been on field-ministry-assignment (almost HMA) since March and as part of every season of rest, we returned to the most basic question of where the Lord seems to be leading us. For the past ten months, Meghan has been serving at a counseling clinic in Colombia, and in April, all of us as a family had an opportunity to visit the church planting work, the team, and the culture of Bogota.

So, [drum roll], **we've been officially invited to join the MTW team in Bogota, Colombia and we're excited about this new opportunity for all of us as a family** (see more below).

Please join us in praying for and **helping us raise \$20,000** for this international move. This will cover flights, shipping, and our initial visa costs.

This was not something we expected. Moving internationally in 2026 was not on our bingo card. But, **the Lord opened a door for us to take this season of rest on the field, forcing all of our ministry commitments into the hands of others, and the same time, He opened an opportunity for us to consider a good fit for us in Colombia.**

In Bogotá, Scott will be walking alongside Colombian pastors and leaders, assisting with church planting, leadership development, pastoral coaching, and helping cultivate gospel centered communities. Meghan will continue serving through the counseling center at United Church of Bogotá, where she has already been serving for the past ten months. Lord willing, Scott will also be offering pastoral counseling through the clinic.

This move also opens important doors for our family. Our four children at home were born in Peru, and Colombia's visa laws will allow them to study, work, and live with more freedom and affordability than they currently have in Panama. For Jack and Angie especially, this gives them a clearer path to take steps into adult life, work, and greater independence.
