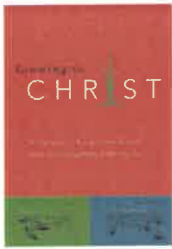
Men's Bible Study on Judges, 9/19

Books are \$5 (cash or check written out to Heritage). It's not too late to join!

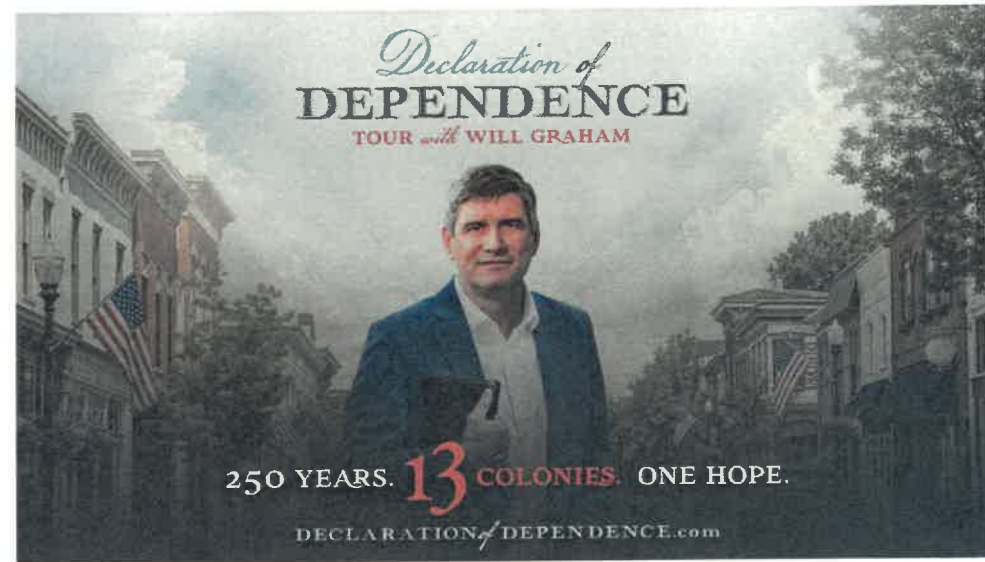
Youth Sunday School Class, 9/20
