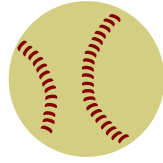

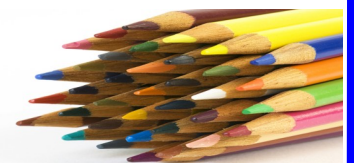
Worship Arts

Home Economics

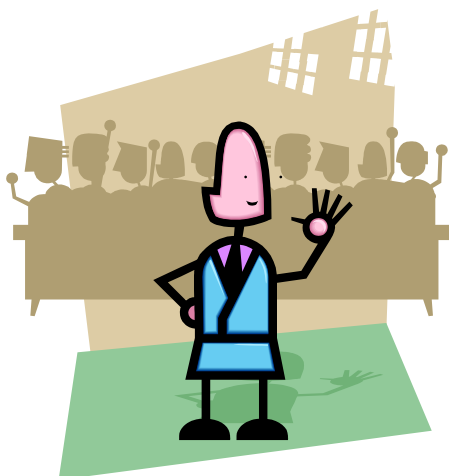

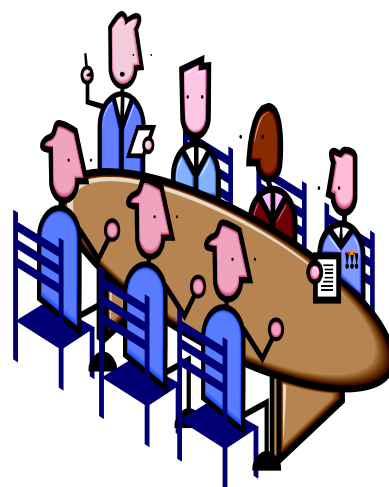
They also learn the importance of preparing for the unexpected and how simple routines can save their sanity.
