#### Jesus is Alive

This month we will celebrate the most important historical event since the creation of the world: Jesus' resurrection from the dead. Sure, Christmas gets most of the attention in our culture, but that is probably because we give each other gifts. Easter; however, should be the most celebrated holiday due to the implications for each individual. Without Jesus coming back from the dead, there would be no reason for hope in the world today. Paul said it like this in 1 Corinthians 15:17, "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins." To be "in our sins" means that the possibility of being reunited in fellowship with God the Father doesn't exist.

Something significant happened though to boost their courage to a whole new level. After watching Jesus be killed and buried, they were physically reunited with Him three days later. Jesus came back from the dead, was fully alive in their presence, and encouraged them to go tell the world! Their courage should be our courage.

John also reminds us what Jesus said in John 14:3, "If I go away and prepare a place for you, I will come back and receive you to Myself, so that where I am you may be also." Still, I have news for you... Jesus is

Consider this for a moment: the disciples did not overcome their fear while Jesus was dead in a tomb. These men were scared for their lives! Their leader was publicly humiliated and killed as a criminal. Notice that none of the 11 disciples came to bury Jesus after He was crucified, not even one of His "inner three" (Peter, James, or John). Where were these devoted followers of Jesus after the Romans crucified Him and put a guard in front of His tomb? They were devastated, doubtful and hiding.
