Job Description

Job Title: Youth Pastor
Full-time

General Description:

Oversees and directs the youth ministry (consisting of children and youth ages 18 and under). Develops and implements the educational and discipleship strategy and programs for children and youth. Must be a vision caster who is a self-starter with excellent communication skills, who is creative and has a genuine passion for ministering to children, youth and parents. Recruits, equips, approves, and evaluates leaders to work in the children and youth ministry. Works collaboratively with Church staff and ministry leaders.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education and Experience

- Must have a Bachelor's Degree in Christian Education, Counseling, Church Leadership or a related field from an accredited four-year college or university; or
- One year of full-time qualifying experience in managing, supervising personnel, and directing children and youth ministry programs may be substituted for each year (30 semester hours) of required college.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Must be a born again believer in Jesus Christ and spiritually mature.
- Must agree to the financial support of the church by contributing at least ten percent (10%) of gross earnings to the church on a consistent basis.
- Performs duties and responsibilities in a manner that glorifies Christ and furthers the mission and ministry purposes of Sweet Home – The Pinnacle of Praise.
- Adheres to church approved guidelines as set forth in Sweet Home – The Pinnacle of Praise's Bylaws and Personnel Manual.
- Must read, agree, and sign Articles of Faith.

Essential Job Functions:

- Leads the church in creating, planning, conducting, and evaluating a comprehensive Children and Youth program.
- Identifies the needs and interests of children and youth within the church and community.
- Develops educational and training projects such as retreats, study sessions, seminars and missions for the various age groups within the children and youth ministry.

- Leads the church to be aware of the latest trends involving youth.
- Provides leadership for the weekly Sunday Worship Service, Midweek Bible Study and other services as deemed necessary.
- Visits local schools of the children and youth of our church.
- Participates in reaching out to local youth and those who have visited the church.
- Coordinates and implements an annual ministry budget proposal and administers that budget as approved.
- Networks with other youth leaders in the community to support youth fellowships.
- Assists with the facilities responsibilities at Sweet Home - The Pinnacle of Praise.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
