QUALIFICATIONS:

Priority consideration will be given to candidates that currently possess a Master's of Divinity Degree from an accredited seminary. Candidates should have five (5) or more years of pastoral experience at a church of comparable size. Candidates must be knowledgeable of Baptist Doctrine, licensed and ordained to the Gospel Ministry by creditable religious organizations.
