The rich heritage of the congregation serves as the basis of its future hopes and dreams.

The Jefferson Street Missionary Baptist Church is an inclusive congregation of baptized believers adhering to the teachings of Christ under the direction of the Holy Spirit. A church dedicated to the principles of God's Word through theologically sound preaching, teaching and evangelizing.
