The Call:

The Third Baptist Church of Chicago, IL is prayerfully seeking an ordained minister to lead our congregation as a full-time Senior Pastor. A qualified candidate will: have pastoral experience, understand life in the city both spiritually and theologically, possess strong administrative and interpersonal skills, and be committed to building intergenerational relationships within and beyond the church building.

Who We Are:

Third Baptist Church of Chicago (TBCoC) was organized by founding Pastor Rev. Elmer L. Fowler on March 8, 1963 in the home of Sister Lelia Kennerson along with a small band of charter members. The first worship service was held Easter Sunday 1963 at John Foster Dulles School. Rev. Fowler selected the symbol of the "Holy Rood" for the church, which represents the three Crosses of Calvary in the Christian faith. As a congregation of the Universal Church of Jesus Christ in the Baptist tradition, TBCoC is to be the Lord's Great House, living out the Greatest Commandment and fulfilling the Great Commission. (2 Timothy 2:20-21; Matthew 22:36-40; Matthew 28:18-20) The Third Baptist Church campus includes several handicap accessible facilities that are used for church and community activities and also are available for rental, including the Heritage Plaza Banquet and Meeting Center, the TBCoC sanctuary, the Elmer L. Fowler Chapel, and the four-story TBCoC Life Center which is equipped with a gym, meeting rooms and classrooms of various sizes and is outfitted with state-of-the-art teleconferencing capabilities. As we fulfill our mission, TBCoC will enhance God's Kingdom in these ways: Increasing in souls added through evangelism; Developing new disciples, learning the faith; Expanding its ministry to serve local and global communities; Growing servant-leaders for the servant ministries of the church; Working for biblical justice through advocacy and activism.

Our Next Senior Pastor:

We are a church of approximately 850 active members with a significant "Seasoned Saints" population. Our next pastor, therefore, must be gifted in the following areas of pastoral ministry:

- Be an authentic person who knows the importance of pastoral care and counseling
 - Be a caregiver at all stages of the life cycle (baby dedications through committal to the ground)
- Be a preacher committed to the Gospel as Good News as well as an interpreter of local, regional, and national crises
- Be actively engaged in community and social justice concerns

- Be excited about equipping the saints for ministry
 - Teach Bible and other life enriching studies that support spiritual growth and social transformation
 - o Leadership development
 - o Evangelism and Discipleship classes to equip believers and nourish the Body of Christ
- Be a sound administrator who follows best practices
- Be passionate about evangelism among young adults and youth
- Be visionary by developing short-range and long-range strategic plans
- Be a person of integrity. Recognizing the high visibility of this calling, avoid the appearance of evil (Romans 14:1-23; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:7-9)

Qualifications:

- Believers baptism by immersion, ordained Baptist (or willing to have ordination recognized by the ABCMetro Chicago), and willing to covenant with the American Baptist Churches in the USA and the Progressive National Baptist Convention, Inc.
- Education Masters of Divinity (MDiv) degree is required. Degree must be from a seminary or divinity school accredited by the Association of Theological Schools.
- Clinical Pastoral Education not required but will be beneficial
- Pastoral Experience A minimum of 5 years as a Pastor or Assistant Pastor is preferred as evidence of administrative and leadership abilities
- Affirms God's anointing upon women and men as called preachers and pastors
