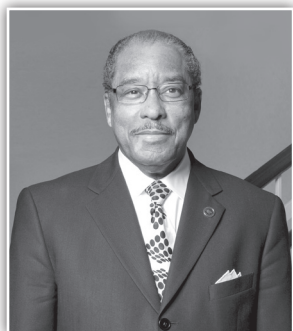


A Message from the Convention President

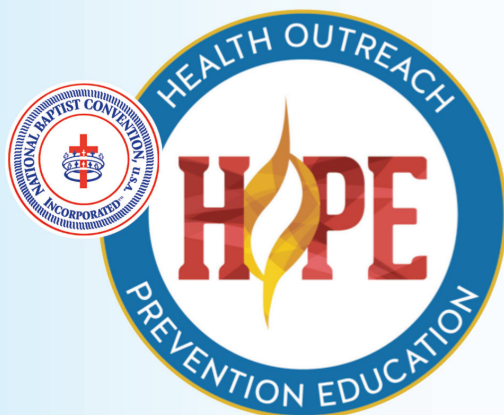
