About Antioch

Antioch Baptist Church, located in the New York City suburb of Bedford Hills, has been Growing, Reaching, and Teaching for 120 years. Our mission is to move Upward and Onward in Christ through love, teaching, and community outreach.

Antioch began as a small group of African-American families that met in their homes for praise and worship service in the late 1800s. Today, Antioch is a diverse congregation with 200 active members and strong ties to the Northern Westchester County community.

Antioch is a loving church.

The Antioch congregation is a family. From those who have grown up in this church and have been members for over 60 years to the newest member waiting to be baptized, love and support are given and received equally. We love one another as Christ has loved us. Just as God is no respecter of persons, Antioch is compassionate and welcoming to all. We are committed to building meaningful and loving relationships with each other and with our neighbors throughout the community. Visitors regularly speak about the Spirit-filled warmth they feel when they attend a worship service at Antioch. Many members travel more than 40 miles to Sunday morning worship service.

Antioch is a community-involved church.

Antioch leads or participates in a number of community events. For over 40 years Antioch has led a county-wide Martin Luther King Jr. birthday celebration. Major elements of the celebration include an interfaith service and a scholarship banquet. We work with a consortium of local churches and synagogues to provide an emergency shelter program for the homeless during the winter months. Members of Antioch were founding members of the Northern Westchester Community Center, and Antioch continues to support many of its initiatives and hosts a fundraising gospel concert every year. Antioch's mission ministry coordinates church-sponsored local mission efforts. Examples include regular visits to local nursing homes, collection of Christmas gifts for the children of inmates at a local prison, and participation in the Junior League's family Christmas-wish program.

Antioch is a teaching church.

Our Church School and Antioch at Study (Christian Education) ministries aim to facilitate Christian maturity, character, and spirituality through sound biblical teaching and exploration. Antioch offers several opportunities every week to study God's word and grow spiritually. Our teachers clarify the Word in a way that brings it to life in our daily walks with the Lord. The Antioch at Study ministry also presents important contemporary issues that warrant deeper investigation and discussion. For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope (Romans 15:4). Additionally, Antioch is devoted to mentoring and counseling our youth, both spiritually and socially. We believe that teaching our youth does not begin and end with Church School on Sunday. Encouraging and supporting every aspect of their lives teaches them to be ambassadors for Christ in all venues of life and equips them to be societal role models and leaders.
