Established in 1893 by founding fathers A. R. B. Taylor, Frank Wallace and George Fayerman, First Baptist Church is located at 28 North Street, Milford, CT. 06460 in the city's historical district. Its current membership is comprised of approximately 180 worshipers who are 95 per cent African-American with the remaining five per cent identifying themselves as Caribbean American, Latino or White. More than 60 per cent of the congregation is female. The mean age of our congregants is 55 years.

The church location in Milford sits between two larger Connecticut cities, New Haven to the north and Bridgeport to our south. Our membership draws largely from these two cities and surrounding communities as well as Milford. While Connecticut's per capita income, listed in 2013 as \$36,775, is celebrated as among the nation's highest, the wealth is disproportionately distributed and the state's larger cities are considerably less prosperous than its many suburban communities.
