Job Description

Church Organist

Summary:

As the primary organist, one serves as a resource of support to foster and coordinate the worship and spiritual life of the congregation through congregational, choral, and instrumental music. As a member of the professional staff, the Church Organist is responsible to the Pastor and Lead Director to develop, plan, manage, and coordinate worship services & related activities.

Purpose:

To provide organ music for worship services and other church functions to include special services, weddings, and funerals.

Education, Skills and Ability:

Be able to display a professional level of musical talent from training and church experience. Have a thorough working knowledge of the congregation's worship services and a theological understanding of church music. Be able to communicate well and in a friendly manner with the Pastor, Lead Director, worship and music ministry members, fellow employees, church choir, praise and worship team, and members of the congregation.

Job Performance Requirements:

- 1. Provide organ music in a professional manner for all worship services
- 2. Applicant must play by ear
- 3. Teach and assist director with teaching parts to the choir
- 4. Keep abreast of different genres of gospel music to include: traditional, urban contemporary, Christian hip hop, gospel jazz, and southern gospel.
- 5. Provide organ music for weddings and funerals with receipt of additional compensation from the parties involved.
- 6. Encourage musical talents and coordinating special musical offerings, including soloists, choirs, and praise dancers in cooperation with the Pastor and Lead Director.
- 7. Arrange for a qualified substitute organist or pianist when absent for church services, and notify the Pastor, Lead Director, and Church Administrator two weeks in advance.

- 8. Arrange for organ and piano maintenance with a qualified organ and piano repair person as needed.
- 9. Assist in the selection of songs.
- 10. Invest 4-8 hours per week in rehearsal, regular church service, and any special services.
- 11. Applicant must be able to flow with the Pastor in spirit on the organ during the preaching portion of worship services.

Possible Additional Opportunities:

1. Select music for the Praise/Worship team

Job Expectations:

- 1. The applicant shall rehearse 1 to 2 times per week to maintain a high quality of music.
- 2. A 90-day and annual performance review will be performed.
- 3. The applicant shall seek professional relationships with other church musicians and keep abreast of developments in worship and liturgy through associations, continuing education, and professional church publications.

Compensation:

Compensation will be based on rehearsals and church service. The annual salary of \$15,600 is paid on a bimonthly schedule. Additional compensation for special services include funerals at \$75.00, weddings at \$100.00 and afternoon services (i.e. Church Anniversary, Pastor's Anniversary, Choir musicals, other church and/or Pastoral engagements within the metro Atlanta area etc...) at \$50.00, and other church and/or Pastoral engagements outside of the metro Atlanta area but within the state of Georgia at \$75.00.
