The New Northside Missionary Baptist Church of St. Louis, Missouri seeks a full-time pastor to oversee a congregation of approximately 600 members. New Northside, The Church Where Everybody Is Somebody, And Christ Is All, was organized in 1902 and this year celebrates 110 years of ministry, under the theme: "A Mighty Fortress."

New Northside holds active membership in the Berean Baptist District Association, The Missionary Baptist State Convention of Missouri and the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc.

New Northside believes and preaches a sound doctrine of salvation with an emphasis on reaching out to the larger community. New Northside encompasses more than two dozen active auxiliaries including the Missionaries, Deaconess, Booster's Club and the Laymen's Movement, all of which complement the overall ministry of the church. We conduct weekly Bible Study, an active Sunday School which meets each Sunday morning followed by a spirit-filled worship experience. Additionally, the church supports several outreach ministries for young people which includes an award winning Drum & Bugle Corp, Vacation Bible School, Music and Dance Ministry, a Scholarship Program, Christian Education Department and Children's Church.

Our urban church complex includes our Primary House of Worship located at 8645 Goodfellow Blvd, several off-site parking areas, a 5000 square foot structure at 6050 Goodfellow Blvd and a 21,000 square foot State-of-the-Art Family Life & Conference Center at 5939 Goodfellow Blvd. This facility encompasses our Day Care Program, Banquet Center, Meeting Rooms and Executive Offices.
