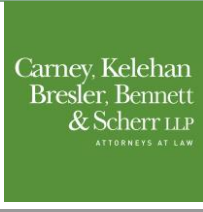
Mobile Crisis Team Clinicians LCSW-C or LCPC - Grassroots Crisis Intervention Center
