Classroom "Project Auction" June 11th

At our "Kindergarten Graduation & Farewell Performance" we will auction off the following classroom projects created by your children.

Mrs. Sam's class painted and decorated a bench with a bible verse from the book of Deuteronomy [11:18-20]. In addition to the bench a children's bible will be included as a memento of the time spent in the two year old class.

Mrs. Jenny's class is decorating a child's play kitchen. "God's Bountiful Blessings Soup Kitchen" is an entertainment center turned in to a play kitchen. Each child will help paint and be able to put there fingerprints on the project. It will include scripture verses and picture for a personal touch.

Mrs. Tonya's class has made a Hand Print Painted Platter, that showcases each of her students hand prints.

Mrs. Gwenna's class Quilt was created by individual student artwork and will be suitable for hanging.

Mrs. Crystal's class has created ABC Art Work entitled "For the Word of God is living and active..."-Hebrews 4:12. This year, Mrs. Crystals' class has learned that listening to God's word means trusting & believing that the word of God is alive and active all around us and that it will touch us if we let it. As it touches us, we become a part of His word as we show our belief and understanding through our words and actions.
