- Do you know what it's like to sit at the breakfast table or in front of the TV with a spouse or loved one and feel **completely alone**?
- Do you know how it feels to be **totally isolated**—in a crowd?

Loneliness in More Than a Feeling

But for many, loneliness is more than a feeling. For them, loneliness is a fact... a sad reality. They are **Actually Alone**.

- Loneliness captures an elderly woman who has lost her life partner of 50 years, her children to drugs and alcohol, and her "friends" to the harsh realities of their own issues and needs. Make new friends? Sure,...if she only could.
- Loneliness washes over the husband whose wife can't – or won't - quit drinking. Oh,...he's sober after years of alcohol addiction. He's sober, but alone...**lonely for the relationship** he and his wife once enjoyed.
- Loneliness attacks the recovering addict. The "drinkin' and druggin'" friends are gone. They have to be gone. But, we miss them. We get lonely for the friendship.
- Loneliness can even affect the one who has experienced the miracle of healing. Like the man at the pool (John 5), everything and everyone changes when Jesus intersects a life with His healing power. The first few steps into the new life can be lonely.

Jesus Has Experienced Loneliness

Seems strange to think of Jesus as lonely, doesn't it? Yet, though surrounded by crowds and the constant companionship of His disciples throughout the 3½ years of His ministry on earth, in His humanity, Jesus experienced loneliness.

Constant, Unbroken Fellowship With the Father

In His divinity as the Only begotten Son of the Father, Jesus enjoyed an unbroken fellowship with His Father and the Holy Spirit before the world was spoken into existence (John 1). The triunity of the Trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – was absolutely loving, holy and complete. In His divine relationship, loneliness was impossible.

Jesus Took On Human Flesh

But, Jesus took on human flesh... Jesus like you and me. (John 1:12-14). Born of a virgin, he grew to become a man. Fully human; fully God. In His Galilean ministry, crowds thronged around Him. Many professed allegiance. Then suddenly **the world wanted Him dead!** His best friends even **abandoned him**. Hanging on the cross, having taken on Himself the sins of the world, even His Father turned from Him. No longer able to sense the Father's presence, Jesus cried, "My God! My God! Why have you forsaken me?" (Matt. 27:46). I cannot imagine the loneliness of the cross.

Jesus Invites You Into Relationship

But, the cross was for a reason; God had intent for the cross. Jesus died for my sin so I don't have to die (Romans 3:23; 6:23). I no longer have to feel alienated from God. I no longer have to be lonely. Jesus invites into relationship with Himself and the Father.

Tell Him you want a relationship with Him... right now. He will come into your life, fill you with His presence, forgive your sin, and make you a new creation!
