T H E I S S U E **Past and Future**

God lives in the Past, Present, and Future—all at once.

He is eternal

Human Beings live on a timeline – a sequence – moving
from Point A to Point B.

We live in the Present only—on a very small piece of that timeline (Mondays, 5 o'clocks, March's, 2012's) However, we sometimes spend too much time in the Past, either regretting the Past, or wishing the Past would be restored. Or we spend too much time in the Future: planning, hoping, *fearing*. It's good to plan and hope, but we need to spend more time in the Present, since that is where we live.

Sometimes, in recovery, **we get stuck**. We get stuck and can't go forward to the next step of healing. When things in the Past, such as sin, guilt, shame, and pain get in the way of how we see our Future, we get stuck: our past distorts our view of the Future with fear and condemnation. If you allow it, Satan will trap you in your past, rendering you unable to move forward because of the weight of guilt and shame.

But, the other trap is just as significant: the future. If you will play the "what if" game with the enemy, you will become paralyzed with fear; unable to take a step because... well... what if?

The Bible says:

*"So, as the Holy Spirit says: **TODAY**, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts" | Hebrews 3:7-8a*

That tells me we are not going to hear God's voice by regretting the Past or worrying about the Future. He meets us in the NOW, not the Future...because we're not really there yet.

There's only one way to deal with the failures and sins of the past: ask Jesus to forgive you; to cleanse you. "... if we admit our sins—make a clean breast of them—he won't let us down; he'll be true to himself. He'll forgive our sins and purge us of all wrongdoing." | 1 John 1:9-10 (The Message). There's no way to answer the "what if" question. We can't know the future. So we trust Jesus with our future. He is the author and finisher of our faith.

Take time today to spend time in the NOW—with **God**. If you do, your issues and fears will begin to be resolved, your perception of the Past will begin to take on a whole new look, and your Future will happen—WITH GOD.

Get UN-stuck. Live in the Present; one day at a time. It's in the present we experience His grace, His power, His presence.
