MINISTRY UPDATES:

- **Living H2O Guatemala Vision Update – “Focusing Cornerstone’s Ministry in Guatemala”:**
 - As we continue to develop our relationships in Guatemala through Children’s HopeChest, the Living H2O team has prayerfully considered, what is the best way to “Help without Hurting?” After further assessing our vision and goals for this aspect of the H2O ministry, a mission and vision trip, and session insight and guidance, **we have refined our orphan ministry in Guatemala to My Special Treasure (MST) only**, rather than supporting two orphanages.
 - In discerning how to best help without hurting both the children and leadership in MST and Nuevo Reto (NR), and our own church members, **it was determined that dividing our efforts, commitments and focus between two orphanages would more likely hurt than help both homes, and possibly hurt us. Thus, we will now focus solely on the spiritual, physical, relational, and financial needs of MST (Caesar and Carol, and the 11 girls currently there).** We know this is hard for those sponsoring children in NR, but we will phase out this relationship over several months. There were many factors which directed this decision, but **the primary factor was a vision and optimism for a relationship with MST.** Our hope is that this relationship will glorify our Lord and bring great joy and hope to a home filled with lovely young ladies needing the love of Christ.
 - **The needs at MST are great. Our goal is to increase our level of financial and relational support by adding additional families to the sponsorship program, support capitol, educational and vocational programs, and meet more medical and dental needs of the girls. Thank you for your continued support as we grow this orphan care ministry.** Please contact H2O with questions.

- **The “Weekly” transforming to The Connection:** The “Weekly” email has GROWN and will now be our “Cornerstone Connection” e-newsletter, containing all of the information that was previously contained in the paper Connection, plus more. It has been enhanced with a Summary / Table of Contents at the beginning and links to help you navigate through the document itself, plus links that enable you to interact with the Cornerstone website. This includes links that allow on-line registration and sign-up, which is more efficient and effective than paper. Also, now the Connection will never get lost – you can always find it in your email inbox, or on the [website](#).
 - **The Cornerstone Quick Connect:** This piece of paper will replace the printed Connection as a resource available Sunday mornings. This will provide a summary of events, activities, and sign-ups, but will not provide a way to register or sign-up for activities. This must be done through this newsletter or directly from the website – both will work. The “Quick Connect” will also provide Worship Notes that can be used during the worship service. The hope is that you will spend your time doing the “Administrative” aspects of our church community at home, and will be able to focus on worship at the ... Worship Service.
 - **The Cornerstone Website:** More effort will now be put into the Cornerstone Website to ensure it contains the information that you need, as well as resources to support our church community. The church calendar now contains all church activities, as well as community activities that affect us. (Let us know if we are missing something!) This is integrated with the on-line registration and sign-up functions. So between the e-Connection and the website, you should be able to get the information and resources you need, and provide information that is needed for our ministries and activities.
 - **Worship Registration:** Instead of TEARING a page out of the old Connection, you will now have a separate “Communication Card” to fill out and put in the offering plate. Please include questions, comments, and prayer requests on the back of this card.

MISSIONARY UPDATES:

- **Asia Church Planters** (names have been removed due to safety concerns):

- Dear Prayer Warriors, Greetings to you all in the most powerful Name of the Lord!
- We are not sure how much current unrest in our city is reported in your local news in the U.S. The law & order situation here is getting bad to worse here. First three months of 2012 had been very difficult for our troubled city. The official count of people who are gunned down stands at 383 not counting how many people are wounded. Just during the past week out of six working days, our city was shut down for three days. Over 50 vehicles were set on fire and 27 people were killed. This kind of senseless target killing in one city, has made people mentally sick and in constant fear of life, it is making life more challenging. Unrest in the city is paralyzing all fields of life. From the first of April, we have stopped reading newspapers as it is heart-breaking to see what is going on here. Please pray for political stability and leaders to make wise decisions.
- On Monday March 19, Asia Church Planter travelled to the Capital City, to visit one Imam that he had never met before. As per his testimony, he has seen the Light of the Gospel. As you can imagine this kind of visits are always very high risk. Asia Church Planter's wife was quite concerned for this meetings, but she supported me to travel this far to meet this person. He wanted to discuss how he might teach the Truth of the Gospel to others in his area of influence.
- We are happy to let you know that even though there were all kinds of concerns for this trip, but Asia Church Planter had a great time with this new bother. Wish, we can share with you more but we are not at liberty to discuss such matters through E-mail. One day, we will sit face to face and share with you all this information. All we can say that we are deeply blessed to know this brother. He has great longing to grow in the wisdom & knowledge of the Gospel of grace. Please pray as we make future plans to meet and discuss matters related to His Kingdom.
- This brother is 74 year of age. He has two wives and many children. On his personal property, he has built a Mosque. Asia Church Planter spent a lot of time listening to his story and had very little time to talk. Which was hard for as you know. Smile... He has come to know the truth of the Gospel of grace but he is not able to openly share his story. He wants to meet with Asia Church Planter regularly so that they can work together to understand the Scriptures and how to share it in a hostile environment with hostile people. Our brother knows many languages including Hebrew and Greek languages. This along is unbelievable. He studied in the UK and was there for over 14 years. He learnt the Truth of the Gospel while we was in UK. He has published some books and is sharing the Truth with others in a very tactful manners. It was so good to spend time with him and one of his wife and a few children in prayer before flying back. He wants us to meet more often. But distance between our two cities is one big drawback. Please pray for wisdom for us to make right decisions to meet this need. Pray for new CP work among the unreached in the Capital City. Pray for our friendship to grow. Pray for safety & security for both of us as we make very aggressive plans for future.
- On March 23, we had one day teaching Seminar. We were expecting 250 to 300 people to attend, but due to serious security situation only 97 people came. We were very



tempted to cancel this event but the night before the Seminar, 38 people came for a whole night prayer time and we all prayerfully decided to go ahead with this program. Asia Church Planter was in this whole night prayer meeting from 11:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. and the next day our Seminar started at 10:00 am and we finished at 6:00 pm. This day long teaching seminars are very successful events to bring people together and teach. It was an encouraging and time of blessing as we spent time learning from the Scriptures. Now please pray for these 97 people that they will grow in the knowledge of the Lord and many will put their trust in the Only Way, Truth & Life.

- During this week, there are many opportunities to speak at different homes & share about the Message of the Cross with people. Apart from our own Fellowship, Asia Church Planter has been invited to preach in two more churches on Good Friday. In one day, These other two churches will meet in the afternoon and our own Fellowship will meet in the evening for a time of reflection and worship. Please pray for strength, wisdom, and clarity of mind and thought for Asia Church Planter and for people that they will receive His Love from the Cross and follow Him regardless of our circumstances.
- Please pray for our physical and spiritual strength too. Pray for our children and grandchildren to grow in the knowledge of the Lord. Pray for Asia Church Planter's wife's health needs. It has been quite a few months now that her legs & feet are swollen. She needs medical help which we are not getting. Asia Church Planter's are still giving him a lot of discomfort. Both ear drums have holes in them and keep oozing. As per Dr. surgery is imperative, but after listening to a few stories, we are quite concerned that he may not get the right kind of care.
- There is no news on the two kidnapped brothers yet and we value you continuous prayers for their safety & peace of mind. Pray for their family members too. One mother is saying, "please set my son free or give me his body. I cannot take this pain any more". This is heart breaking.
- We wish you a very blessed Easter. Thank you so much for your prayers and support.

- **Roberta Brown, Japan:** "My hope is to return to Japan by the next English teaching semester and I am trusting God to provide the financial support needed in order to return. Please be praying that in God's gracious timing this can happen, and be considering whether there is anything more that you as a church can do to help make this a reality. 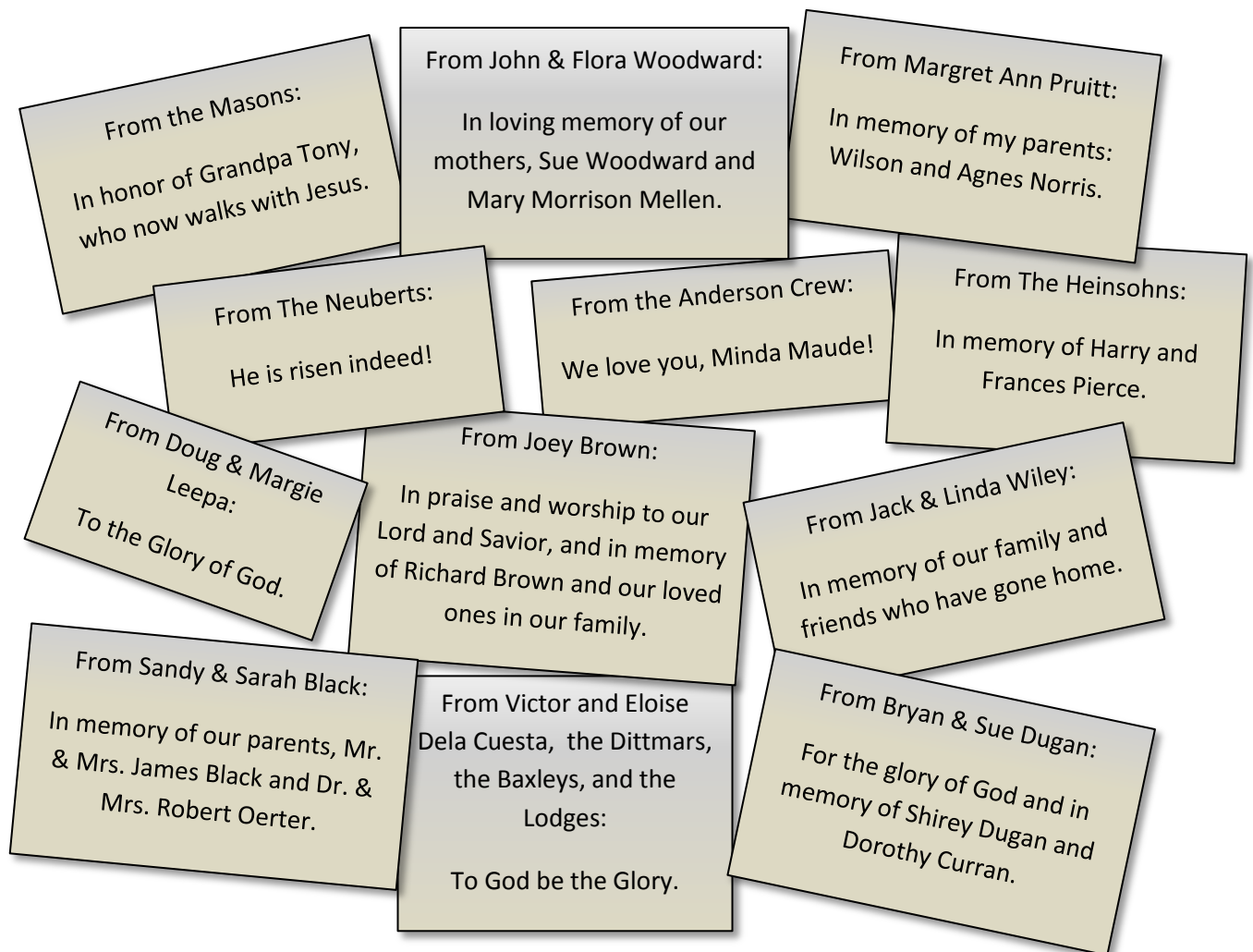
Hymn of the Month: "Let Us Sing and Love and Wonder"

A hymn, which expresses glory and dominion to Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, is "Let Us Love and Sing and Wonder." The text was written by John Newton (1725-1807). In 1779 Newton, along with poet William Cowper, compiled three books of the Olney Hymns, but Newton had published other hymns previously, such as this one which first appeared in his 1774 work *Twenty Six Letters on Religious Subjects*, by Omicron. The modern text has been altered. The tune (All Saints Old) most commonly used with "Let Us Love and Sing and Wonder" is by an anonymous composer and is taken from the Darmstadt Gesangbuch of 1698. The song gives several reasons why we should praise the one who washed us from our sins with His blood.
