These young leaders were immersed in *the life* and



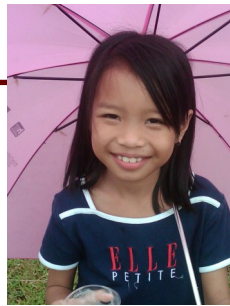
they *caught* it. You know what I'm saying? We pray for a great move of God among the Youth in the mountains of Laos.

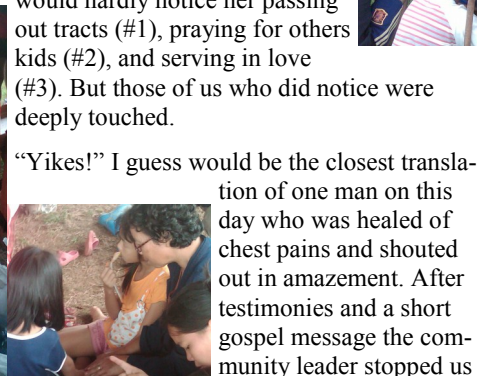
