Dept. at the rank of Sergeant after 27 years of service. During his
time with LVMPD he worked undercover, as a training officer,
and a traffic enforcement officer. His "Pain Behind The Badge"
seminar has challenged officers across America. He is devoting his
retirement to educating law enforcement and first responders on
dealing with PTSD and suicide. Clarke founded the non-profit
organization Cops Racing Against Violence through Education
(CRAVE) and is the author of two books: "My Life for Your Life"
and "Daddy I Worry About You."

Tracie Paris has been a Registered Nurse for the past 29 years. She has worked as a Trauma/ER Nurse, Outpatient Surgery Nurse and Charge Nurse. In 2006 she was honored as 'Nurse of the Year'.
