THE POWER OF PRIDE

Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.

PRIDE: 1) A high or inordinate opinion of one's own dignity, importance, merit, or superiority, whether as cherished in the mind or as displayed in bearing, conduct, etc. 2) Pride is a conceited sense of one's superiority. To be arrogant, haughty or swelling. 3) It is deception. It believes something about yourself that isn't true.
4) Pride exalts "Me, Self, and I" above all others.
