1. Defend your and .

James 1:19 Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all be guick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry.

Mark 4:9 Then he said, "Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand."

Job 31:1 I made a covenant with my eyes not to look with lust at a young woman.

Matthew 5:27-29 "You have heard the commandment that says. 'You must not commit adultery.' 28 But I say, anyone who even looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart. 29 So if your eye-even your good eye-causes you to lust, gouge it out and throw it away.
