1 Samuel 15: 22-23 But Samuel replied: "Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams. ²³ For rebellion is like the sin of divination, and arrogance like the evil of idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, he has rejected you as king."

6. The submission of our _____to God is more important than our religious practices.

MSG: Do you think all God wants are sacrifices— empty rituals just for show? He wants you to listen to him! Plain listening is the thing, not staging a lavish religious production. Not doing what God tells you is far worse than fooling around in the occult. Getting self-important around God is far worse than making deals with your dead ancestors. Because you said No to God's command, he says No to your kingship.

ERV: Being stubborn and doing what you want is like the sin of worshiping idols.

I Samuel 15:23-26 Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, he has rejected you as king. ²⁴ Then Saul said to Samuel, "I have sinned. I violated the Lord's command and your instructions. I was afraid of the men and so I gave in to them. ²⁵ Now I beg you, forgive my sin and come back with me, so that I may worship the Lord." ²⁶ But Samuel said to him, "I will not go back with you. You have rejected the word of the Lord, and the Lord has rejected you as king over Israel!"

LIVING IT OUT LOUD

Begin each day with a declaration of your faith:

"Today I surrender my will to you, God. I declare the Lordship of Jesus Christ over my life. I submit my will, my desires and my wants to you God. I choose to follow your plan for my life today. Lead me, guide me and teach me by your Holy Spirit who lives in me.

I renounce temptation and sin before it ever approaches me. I reject the ways of this world and I choose to submit to God and resist the devil. I am God's child. His grace empowers me to live like Him. I will talk, walk, act, give and respond like He would because His nature abides in me and I'm in Him. I declare Jesus is Lord of my life today!"
