1. Your relationship with HIM.

2 Corinthians 5:17-18 (MSG) Now we look inside, and what we see is that anyone united with the Messiah gets a fresh start, is created new. The old life is gone; a new life burgeons! Look at it! All this comes from the God who settled the relationship between us and him, and then called us to settle our relationships with each other.

John 15:5 (MSG) I am the Vine, you are the branches. When you're joined with me and I with you, the relation intimate and organic, the harvest is sure to be abundant. Separated, you can't produce a thing.

2. Your relationship with the WORD.

James 1:21 (NKJV)

Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

John 15:7 (NKJV)

If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

Mark 4:20 (MSG)

But the seed planted in the good earth represents those who hear the Word, embrace it, and produce a harvest beyond their wildest dreams.

3. Your relationship with the **BODY**.

1 Corinthians 12:14 (MSG)I want you to think about how all this makes you
more significant, not less. A body isn't just a single part blown up into
something huge. It's all the different-but-similar parts arranged and functioning
together.

Ephesians 4:15–16 (NLT) Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the

church. ¹⁶ He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its
own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is
healthy and growing and full of love.

4. Your relationship with the HOLY SPIRIT.

John 14:15–16 (NKJV) If you love Me, keep My commandments. ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with
you forever

5. Your relationship with OTHERS.

2 Corinthians 5:20 (MSG) We're Christ's representatives. God uses us to
persuade men and women to drop their differences and enter into God's work
of making things right between them. We're speaking for Christ himself now:
Become friends with God; he's already a friend with you.
