1. Biblical leadership is the _____ standard for all leadership.

1 Timothy 3:1 NLT This is a trustworthy saying: "If someone aspires to be a church leader (Bishop, Overseer, Pastor), he desires an honorable position."

2. Leadership is not based upon title or rank, but an individual's _____.

- Most people are infatuated with titles. True leaders are only infatuated with results.

1 Timothy 3:2 NLT So a church leader must be a man whose life is above reproach. He must be faithful to his wife.

3. Faithfulness begins in the _____. If we will cheat on those we love the most... we will cheat on those we serve!

1 Timothy 3:2 NLT He must exercise self-control, live wisely, and have a good reputation.

Galatians 5:22-23 NLT But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,²³ gentleness, and self-control.

4. Excellence of character must be the foundation for our _____.

1 Timothy 3:2 NLT He must enjoy having guests in his home and he must be able to teach.

1 Timothy 3:3 NLT He must not be a heavy drinker or be violent. He must be gentle, not quarrelsome, and not love money.

1 Timothy 3:4 NLT He must manage his own family well, having children who respect and obey him. ⁵For if a man cannot manage his own household, how can he take care of God's church?

1 Timothy 3:6 NLT A church leader must not be a new believer, because he might become proud, and the devil would cause him to fall.

1 Timothy 3:8 NLT In the same way, deacons must be well respected and have integrity. They must not be heavy drinkers or dishonest with money.
