



10. _____ OR COOPERATE PRAYER

- This prayer unites a body of believers together in faith and prayer.
- Acts 4:29–31 Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. **30** Stretch out your hand to heal and perform miraculous signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus.” **31** After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
- 1 Corinthians 12 The Body of Christ

11. THE PRAYER OF _____

- John 16:13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. **14** He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you.
- John 10:27 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. NIV
- Psalms 4:4 says, “Meditate within your heart on your bed and be still.”
- Proverbs 3:5-8 “Trust GOD from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. Listen for GOD's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track. Don't assume that you know it all. Run to GOD! Run from evil! Your body will glow with health, your very bones will vibrate with life!” (Message Bible)

FLAVORS OF PRAYER

Ephesians 6:18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

1. THE PRAYER OF _____

- This prayer is used when we confess our sin to God.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

2. THE PRAYER OF _____ (Luke 22:42)

- This prayer is a dedication of our lives to God for His use and purpose.
- Luke 22:42, (Jesus prayed) “Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.”

3. THE PRAYER OF _____

- This prayer is surrendering a situation to the Lord.
- 1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
- Matthew 6:31 So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ **32** For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. **33** But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

4. THE PRAYER OF _____

- This prayer is used when we bring our needs and requests to God.

- Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
- Mark 11:24 says, “Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.”
- James 5:15 And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven.”

5. THE PRAYER OF _____

- This prayer is based upon our rights and privileges as a child of God.
- Luke 9:1-2 When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases, and he sent them out to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
- Luke 10:19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.
- Matthew 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. 19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”

6. PRAYER IN THE _____

- This kind of prayer is used when you don't know how to specifically pray.
- Acts 2:1-4
- Romans 8:26–27 26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. 27 And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will.
- It is used to edify your life.
- 1 Corinthians 14:4 he who speaks in a tongue edifies himself.

7. THE PRAYER OF _____

- This prayer unites your faith with that of another believer.
- Matthew 18:19–20 Again I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them.

8. THE PRAYER OF _____

- This is a prayer on the behalf of someone else.
- Romans 8:27 And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will.
- Colossians 4:12 Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in **prayer** for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured.

9. THE PRAYER OF _____ AND THANKSGIVING

- This prayer is coming to God for no other reason but to express our love, honor, and gratitude.
- John 4:23–24 says, “Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.”
- Luke 24:52–53, “Then they worshiped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy. And they stayed continually at the temple, praising God.”
- Acts 13:2 While *they were worshiping the Lord* (NKJV says, “*As they ministered to the Lord...*”) and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, ‘Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.’”
