SUNDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2015 PART 8: BODY SNATCHERS

1 Corinthians 12:24-25 . . . But God has put the body together, giving greater honor to the parts that lacked it, 25 so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.

Matthew 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. ### A FISHING STORY - LUKE 5:1-11

- 1. PUT OUT INTO THE DEEP WATER
  - If we want to "go deep" in God? Find His LOST kids!
- 2. LET DOWN THE NETS FOR A CATCH
  - We have to make ourselves available for God to use.
- 3. WE'VE WORKED HARD
  - Regardless of how many times we have let down the net we have to be willing to do it again.
- 4. BUT BECAUSE YOU SAY SO
  - It is important that we are led by the Holy Spirit.
- 5. WHEN THEY HAD DONE SO
  - We must put action to our faith!
- 6. THEY CAUGHT SUCH A LARGE NUMBER THEIR NETS BEGAN TO BREAK
  - When we are faithful to follow Christ's instructions we're going to see life changing results.
- 7. THEY SIGNALED THEIR PARTNERS TO HELP THEM
  - Our goal is not to just fill up Rock, but cause every church in Colorado Springs to be full.

- 8. FILLED BOTH BOATS SO FULL THAT THEY BEGAN TO SINK
  - God is able to do immeasurably more than all we could ask or imagine!
- 9. THEY WERE ASTONISHED AT THE CATCH OF FISH THEY HAD TAKEN
  - RFC Motto: "I want to do something so big, it is destined to fail without You, Lord. Something so great it takes a miracle to do!"
- 10. DON'T BE AFRAID: FROM NOW ON YOU WILL FISH FOR PEOPLE
  - What is one of the biggest issues that stop us from talking to someone about Jesus? FEAR!
- 11. THEY LEFT EVERYTHING AND FOLLOWED HIM
  - Nothing was more valuable to them!

# THE NET SALVATION PLAN - EVERYONE WIN ONE

- KNOW: Get to know everyone seated around you before the message begins or during the "greet and meet" time at the end of worship. Write down their names. Now you will be able to call them by name if you end up going to pray for them.
- CAST THE NET: While Pastor presents the invitation YOU pray for all of those present in service that need Jesus in their lives.
- **3. I WANT JESUS:** Respond <u>immediately</u> and go to a person in your section with their hand in the air. Men to men, women to women.
- **4. CONNECT:** Introduce yourself, get their name, and tell them you are here to pray with them.
- **5. LOCATE:** Are they starting NEW or starting OVER in their walk with God?
- REAFFIRM: Let them know you are proud of them!
- 7. **PRAY:** Lead them in a simple prayer of repentance. Other believers who have gathered should join in repeating the prayer.

**8. BIBLE:** The ushers will bring a Bible to give the individual. Encourage them to read the Gospel of John this week.

#### 9. FOLLOW UP IMMEDIATELY AFTER SERVICE:

- CARD: Encourage them to fill out a CONNECTION CARD to record their decision and drop it off at Guest Info. Volunteer to take it for them.
- b. PRAYER: Write down their name and tell them you commit to daily pray for them this week. Ask if you could get a phone number to check in with them in a couple of days (men to men, women to women only) and feel free to share your name and number with them.
- c. CALL: Call them by Wednesday. Introduce yourself again and ask if they have any questions or if there is anything you can pray with them about. Invite them back to church this Sunday. Ask to meet them a few minutes before service begins so you can introduce them to other RFC members.

#### 10. BUILD ROOTS:

- a. Stay connected with them for the next several weeks.
- b. Share what God has done in your life.
- c. Challenge them to "feed their faith" by reading their Bible, watching past sermons online, or recommend any books that have helped you grow in your walk with God.
- d. Encourage them to watch the teaching series, "You've Got The Power," to learn more about the power of God and the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.
