The Elders who are instructors have other missions in the church, in other words they are over tasked. Clearly this program would benefit with instructors that are committed to the mission. Instructors that is exclusive to the mission of teaching. My vision to have instructors that are dedicated and exclusive to this task/not shared. They are able to invest time, energy (phone calls/visits) and a love to mentor others in the faith. We continue to seek out people for this task.

The Prison Ministry program was invited to participate in a visitation with the Mike Biber Prison Ministry Team to the Riverside Unit for female inmates with the St James Baptist Church. There were over 50 women involved in the visitation.
- Our Outreach Ministry is involved in a community organization, Christian Churches Collaborating for Chang in the criminal justice system (4C's) involving 13 other churches in the community. We were invited to City Wide Conference in Waco, TX for a panel discussion on re-entry for inmates. We had an event at Alpha involving the 4C's, the theme was Encouragement for Ministry, Guest Speaker Judge Harriet Murphy and Spoken Word by our Pastor Gordon Jones.
- Our final activity will be a Christian New Year's Eve Gala which the Outreach Ministry has partnered with our sister church in Bastrop designed for fellowship with other sister churches, community churches and organizations. The funds raised in this event will be donated to a Youth Project Praise N Fitness League (PNFL).

Which goals have not been accomplished and why not?

One our main goals were to be involved with community ministries. An opportunity to unite with the angel tree was not realized because we were not able register in a timely fashion. But the Prison Ministry and our Outreach Ministry were able to collaborate with a ministry within the church family. In this collaboration we united with the Dorcas Ministry and collected children's gifts for eight families.
