Mercy Me.



Wyoming "Son of a Gun" Beans

From the kitchen of Deb White

Ingredients

¾ Ib Bacon (chopped)

1 onion (chopped)

64 oz Canned Pork and Beans 64oz = 2quarts or 8cups

34 Cup Brown Sugar

- 1 ¼ Cups Ketchup
- 1 ½ Tbsps Worcestershire Sauce
- 1 Tbsps Garlic Powder or Fresh
- 3/4 tsp Black Pepper (coarse ground)

Directions

Brown bacon, onions, and garlic in a skillet.

Drain excess liquid of the beans add to crockpot.

Thoroughly mix in brown sugar, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce and pepper.

Cook at low heat (simmer) until liquid is absorbed and mixture is dark in color.

Stir frequently to keep from burning.

Cook for at least 20 min.

Tonight we held our quarterly "Women at Crossroads" meeting. Gynny provided our devotional and reminded us that we are loved. She also reminded us that no matter what life throws at us, we are to shine a light that points to Him. There should be something "different" about our responses to life. We are told we make a statement to everyone with whom we come in contact. No matter what we think, we are always being watched...by our kids, our grandkids, our parents, a co-worker, a friend, a spouse, a store clerk, a neighbor, a fellow student... or a brother or sister in Christ. I heard it said recently "We do just two things when we are with people: we either speak Life into them, or we drain them." Ouch!

I have a small devotional book by Chuck Swindoll, *Wisdom for the Way*. These words reminded me of the importance of my attitude... and how I share it with others.

Promote Peace

A "peacemaker" is the servant who…first, is at peace with himself – internally, at ease…not agitated, ill-tempered, in turmoil…and therefore, not abrasive. Second, he/ she works hard to settle quarrels, not start them…is accepting, tolerant, finds no pleasure in being negative….

Ever been around Christians who are *not* peacemakers? Of course. Was it pleasant? Did you sense a servant's heart? Were you built up and encouraged...was the body of Christ strengthened and supported? You know the answers....

Few things are more godlike than peace. When we promote it, pursue it, model it, we are linked directly with Him.
