

REQUIREMENTS

You MUST (Be):

- □ a US citizen
- □ at least 16 years old (to register) and 18 years old to vote by Election Day, Nov 3 to VOTE in 2020.
- live in North Carolina <u>and</u> in the precinct where you will vote for 30 days before the election day
- ☐ NOT claim the right to vote in another state

If you have been convicted of a felony, YOU CAN REGISTER AND VOTE with the conditions that you:

- 1. have finished your felony sentence and
- 2. are <u>not</u> on probation or on parole for that sentence.

The 2020 Census

Am I required to respond to the 2020 Census?

Yes, you are required by law to respond to the 2020 Census (Title 13, U.S. Code, Sections 141 and 193). **New Deadline**: October 31, 2020

NOTE: Per the **You Can Vote** Community calls, for **every unreported community member**, **we lose \$16,000** and **for every unreported family of 5** we, the community, are **deprived** of approximately **\$100,000**.
