- 3. Do you agree with King Solomon that history simply repeats itself over and over? Generations come and generations go and each generation simply does the same things over and over.
- 4. What do you think the purpose of life is all about? Why are we here? Discuss as a group. Then read Ephesians 1:4-5. Discuss.
