Into your hands, O merciful Savior, we commend your servant Jim ...

Dear People of St. Michael's,

Many of us have been reeling in response to learning of the Tuesday morning death of Fr. Jim Bullion. One personal impression that will no doubt grow through Friday's visitation and Saturday's funeral is the diversity of souls whose lives have been touched by Jim and the diversity of their stories.

For those who don't know, Jim presided at the 7:45 a.m. Eucharist this past Sunday. He seemed very

present, imparting a lot of care and heart to his priestly role. Was it just a coincidence that my sermon opened with a quote from a book that introduces children to cycles of life and death? "There is a beginning and an ending for everything that is alive. In between is living."

What's 'in between' seems to be a primary spiritual focus of the church's season of Advent. We live in between life and death; in between Christ's first incarnation and his coming again; in between choices in our lives that result in just going through the motions or that are faithful and intentional.

A commitment to the latter kind of choices was viscerally expressed by one parishioner who was away on a business trip when his wife called to tell him of Jim Bullion's death. "Oh, honey," he said at one point, "We've got to make every day count." It's the same message, really, that the prophets and Jesus deliver to us throughout Advent.

May we all, as Jim Bullion did, make every day and every choice and every relationship count - in this time of grief, in this season of Advent and always.

Food for the Journey: Sunday Adult Formation


The conversation begins after the 9:30 a.m. service (approximately 10:05 a.m.)


In The Parish Family


