Reviewed Alternatives for Future SUMC Facility

- Stay in current facility raising funds to do needed repairs and upgrades without selling any of the current property
- Stay in the current facility raising funds to do needed repairs and upgrades and sell the back portion of property to help with financing
- Sell the front third of the property to Chick-fil-A and rebuild on the back of the property
- Lease the front third of the property to Chick-fil-A and rebuild on the back of the property
- Sell all of the current property and find another location in Silverdale to rebuild

Brainstorm List of Facility Needs whether we stay in current building and remodel or rebuild –This is also not a definitive list, but are factors to consider as we move forward.

- Kitchen cooking, dishes, walk in freezer

District Presentation -- Lynn Magnuson and Jim Craig from the UM Puget Sound District Committee on Property and Location gave a brief overview of their role in assisting churches who are selling, buying or remodeling property. This committee "walks" with a congregation through any large building changes. Their purpose is to be a resource for congregations to get necessary information about sign-off procedures from the conference, financing resources, compliance with ADA and energy efficiency regulations, etc. The district needs to approve any church remodel/construction cost is greater than 25% of the value of the current building and/or when there is the sale of any property.
