### Coming from the South:

Take the I-15 North to the I-215 North, follow signs to I-10 East. Exit Tennessee off the I-10 East. Go left back under the freeway to Lugonia and turn right. Follow Lugonia on up the hill. Lugonia turns into Mentone Road and then into Mill Creek Road. When you see the sign on the right which says Mountain Home Creek Village you will take the first left after that sign and there will be a left turn lane. Make that left turn and after you turn you will see a big red house. Just follow the dirt road up a ways to the entrance which will be on the right.

### Coming from the 210 Freeway:

Southbound Crenshaw Bl between Rodeo Rd and Exposition Bl

STREET CLOSURE

## SUMMARY

Metro's contractor, Walsh-Shea Corridor Constructors (WSCC), will be implementing three weekend street closures for eastbound and westbound traffic on Rodeo Rd between Crenshaw Bl and Bronson Av; and a southbound street closure on Crenshaw Bl between Exposition Bl and Rodeo Rd. The first weekend closure will take place on Friday, August 18, 2017 starting at 9pm through 6am Monday. The closures are necessary to install additional piles as a support of excavation for Expo Station.

During the closures, the following detours will be implemented:

### Eastbound Detour:

- Right on Crenshaw Bl
- Left on MLK Bl
- Left on Western Bl
- Right on Exposition Bl

### Westbound Detour:

- Slight right turn onto Exposition Bl (past Western Av).

### Southbound Detour:

- Right on Jefferson Bl
- Left on La Brea Av
- Left on Rodeo Rd.
- Slight right on MLK Bl
- Right on Crenshaw Bl

## ESSENTIALS

**WHAT:** Street closure to install additional piles as a support of excavation for Expo Station

**WHEN:** The weekends of August 18, 2017, August 25, 2017 and September 8, 2017 from 9pm Friday to 6am Monday, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** Southbound Crenshaw Bl between Exposition Bl and Rodeo Rd; eastbound and westbound Rodeo Rd between Crenshaw Bl and Bronson Av

**DURATION:** Three weekends

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Southbound access on Crenshaw Bl will be restricted between Exposition Bl and Rodeo Rd. Lane reductions will be implemented starting at 30<sup>th</sup> St. Local access will be maintained.

Eastbound and westbound traffic on Rodeo Rd will be restricted between Crenshaw Bl and Bronson Av. Lane reductions will be implemented starting on Murfield Rd through Cherrywood Av. Local access will be maintained.

Two northbound lanes will be maintained on Crenshaw Bl.

Work on this site will take place 24 hours. Sound from the construction will be monitored.

### RESUMEN

El contratista de Metro, Walsh-Shea Corridor Constructors (WSCC), implementará un cierre de la calle durante tres fines de semana para el tráfico en dirección este y oeste en la calle Rodeo entre el bulevar Crenshaw y la avenida Bronson y en dirección sur en el bulevar Crenshaw entre el bulevar Exposition y la calle Rodeo. El primer cierre de fin de semana será el viernes, 18 de agosto de 2017 de 9pm a 6am del lunes. Los cierres son necesarios para la instalación de pilotes adicionales que servirán como apoyo de excavación de la estación Expo.

Durante los cierres, los siguientes desvíos serán implementados:

#### Desvío en dirección este:

- Derecha en el bulevar Crenshaw
- Izquierda en el bulevar MLK
- Izquierda en el bulevar Western

- Derecha en el bulevar Jefferson
