African American Marines were segregated, attending

basic training at Montford Point, North Carolina. Approximately 2,000 African American Marines received basic training at Montford Point between 1942 and 1949. These men were drafted into military service to fight in World War II.

The two individuals hailed - or blamed - for swaying President Franklin Roosevelt to start reforming (in 1940) the armed forces were his wife, Eleanor Roosevelt, and the black labor activist A. Philip Randolph.
